Mount Aloysius College Graduation Requirements:

- Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.0 or higher
- Completion of all major course work with a grade of C or better
- Completion of 30 credits of 300/400 level course work at MAC with 18 credits being in the major
- Completion of last 30 credits in residence at MAC
- Completion of a total 120 credits for the degree.
