Dual Admission Agreement Mount Aloysius College and Penn Highlands Community College

Advantages:

- 1. Students will complete their general education requirements at Penn Highlands Community College except for an upper-level Faith and Reason course, an upper-level Aesthetics course, and Mount Aloysius-specific courses, including CORE 100 What's the Big Idea: Effective Reasoning and Communication, CORE 200 Strategies for Changemakers I, and CORE 400 Strategies for Changemakers II. These courses are specific to the institutional learning outcomes and cannot be transferred.
- 2. Once the student transitions to Mount Aloysius College, they will take Mount Aloysius-specific courses. These courses in the final semester will count toward their associate degree at Penn Highlands and will be taken at Mount Aloysius College.
- 3. This collaboration will allow a seamless transition of students into the pre-licensure BSN program once students meet the required GPA of 2.5 as well as a 2.5 Cumulative GPA in their science courses which include: Microbiology, Anatomy and Physiology I, Anatomy and Physiology II, Nutrition (Diet Therapy for Nursing Students), and General Chemistry (Introduction to Chemistry).
- 4. Advisor at PHCC and MAC to ensure the students meet progression criteria into the pre-licensure BSN program.

^{**}Please note that all transfer courses must have a grade of C or better to be eligible for transfer to Mount Aloysius College.**
